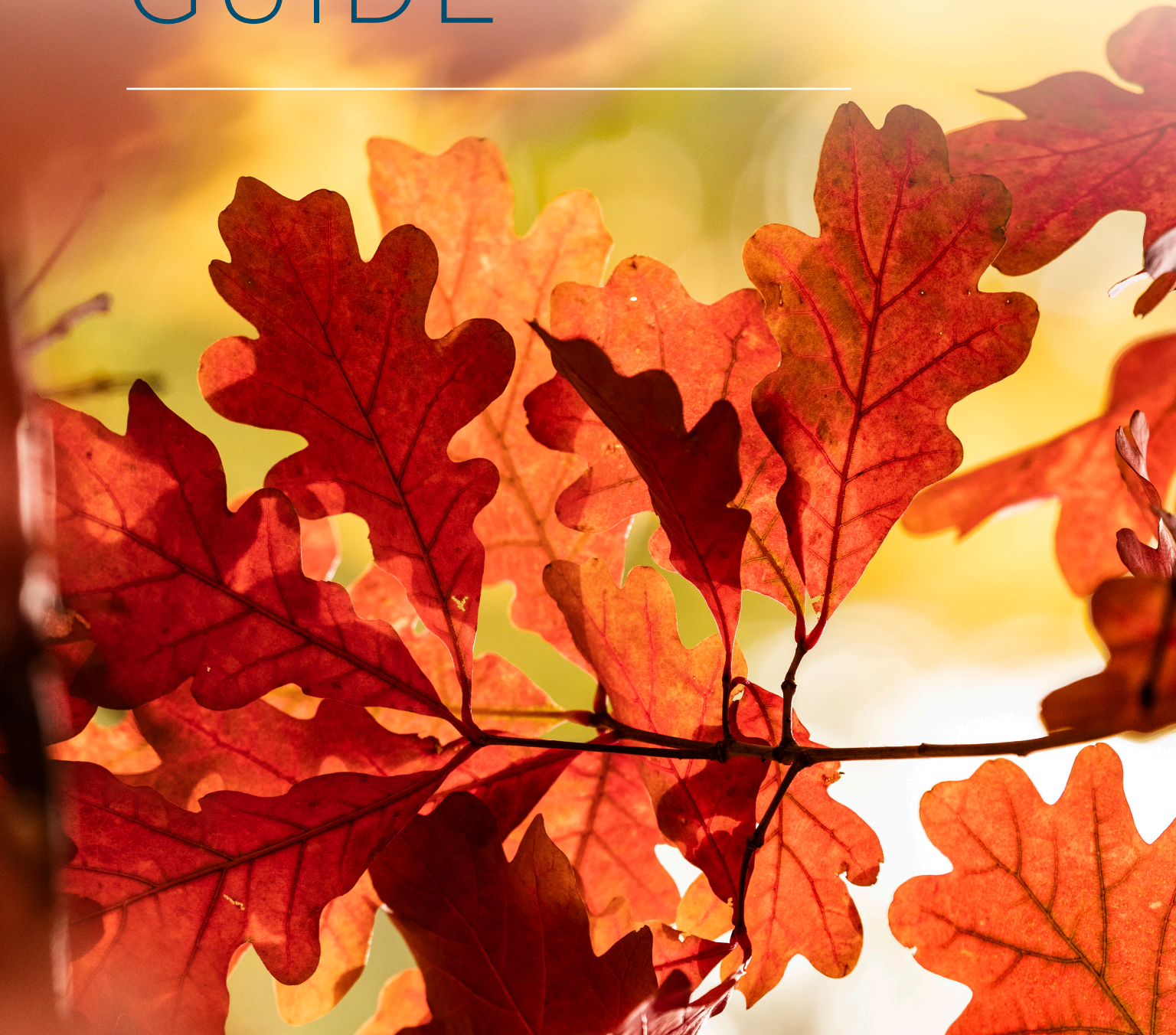

YOUTH OUTDOOR EDUCATION

Let your child's curiosity come alive outside during this inquiry-based, hands-on program. Parents will drop off youth with a Museum educator who will help them uncover the wonders of the natural world. We'll explore the freshwater resources around us (including Doan Brook and Wade Lagoon), learn how to complete a water-quality assessment, and discover how to be better stewards of our environment. Finally, we'll explore the Museum's research on amphibian ecology and how water quality affects local populations.

FAMILY OUTDOOR EDUCATION

Let your family's curiosity come alive outside during these inquiry-based, hands-on programs that cover a range of natural history topics. Families will join in the fun as a Museum educator helps them uncover the wonders of the natural world. Group size is limited; programs are first come, first served.

SHOW & TELL

This year's Show & Tell programs will be virtual. Show & Tell is designed for families and children of all ages, with each program featuring a special scientist or resource person who will make science fun and understandable. Enjoy a short 15- to 20-minute show-and-tell presentation. Afterward, the presenter(s) will answer kids' questions sent via chat.

Join Museum educators each month as we explore a diverse range of natural history topics through engaging, inquiry-based learning.
