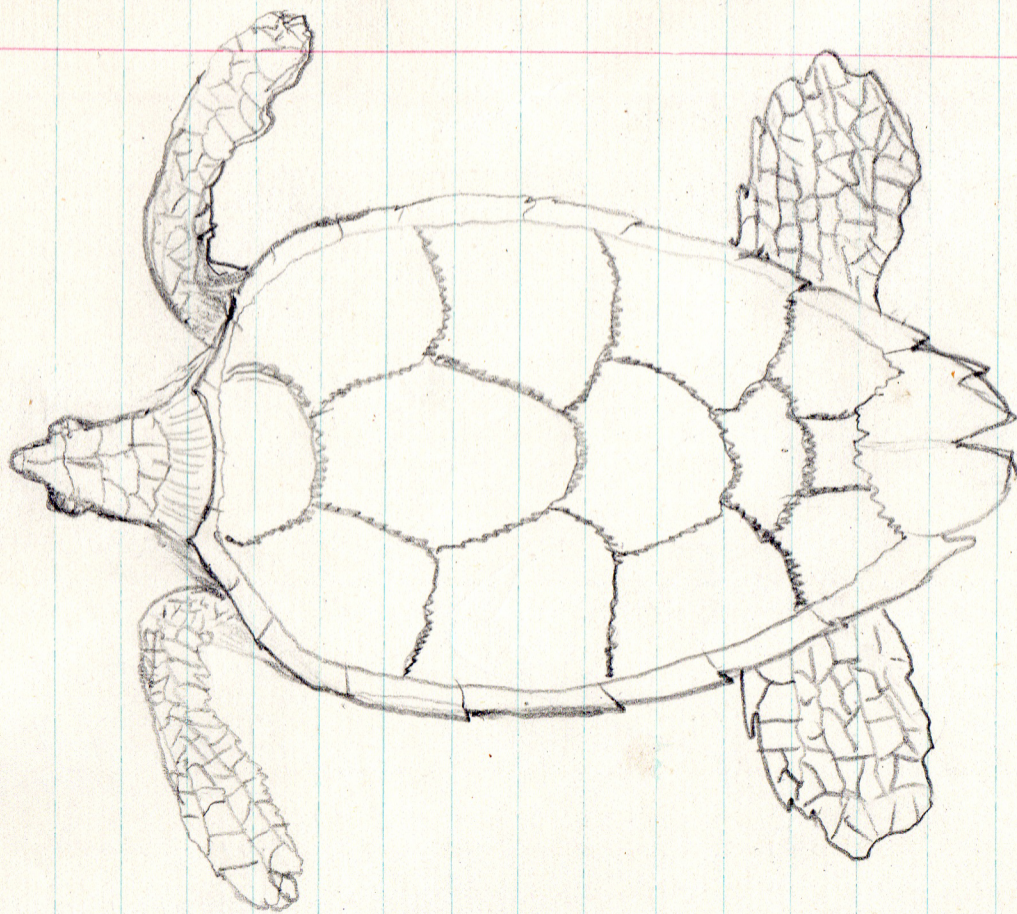


Caught ASCENSION ISLAND JAN. 21, 1926.

HAWKSBILL TURTLE



Eyes: Pupil - Black.
Iris - very fine network of
silver threads with
dark Orient Blue.

General color of back before cleaning:
after part of shell covered with fine Fuscous
colored moss. Balance of shell a very dirty soy
green clouded and mottled and specked with
Spinach Green. Back of head, ^{plates} Olivaceous Black (#3),
Reticulations Mustard Yellow. Soft skin around
eye clouded with Dark Olive Gray and Mustard
yellow, with hint of Zinc Orange.

After cleaning: Irregular large splotches &
mottlings clouded together of Carnelian Red,
translucent Etain Blue, Old Gold, Brownish
Drab, Dursby Drab, Chamois and Reed Yellow.
Reticulations Colonial Buff. Plates Olivaceous
Black.

Belly: Plates Honey yellow in center shading
to cream buff on edges of plates. Soft skin
Colonial Buff. Plates on lower side of
flippers: center spot of Olivaceous black
shading to Primuline yellow & then to
cream color on edges of plates.
